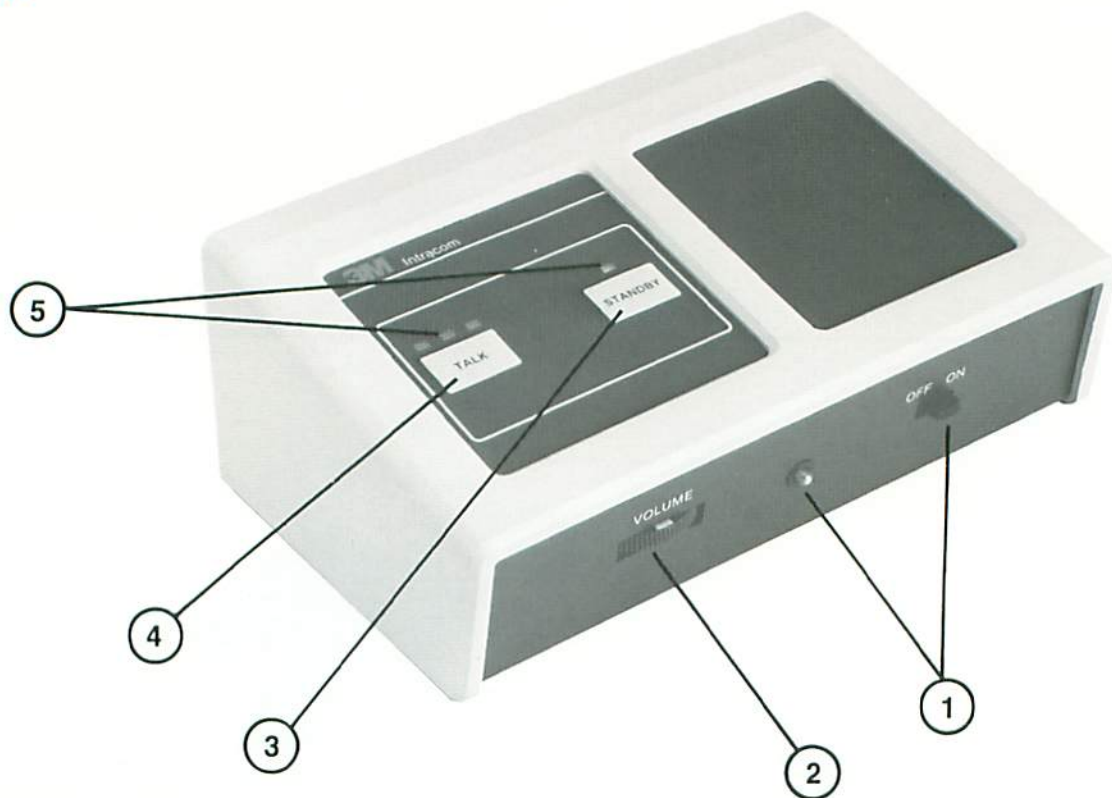

## Introduction

The 3M Brand INTRACOM System is precision-built for reliable operation in continuous-duty applications. The Model D-15 provides maximum voice clarity under various noise conditions.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The System should be installed by an authorized 3M Sound Products dealer representative for proper connection. Before using your Intracom System, please read these instructions carefully.

# Model D-15 Intracom



## Operating Controls

- 1. Power Switch** Activates power to the Intracom. The green "power-on" light indicates the system is ready to operate.
- 2. Volume Control** Adjusts internal speaker (listen) sound level.
- 3. Standby Touch Switch** Silences Intracom audio to eliminate undesired pickup and reconnects optional music/message source to the external speaker. The standby mode releases automatically with vehicle detection or manually by touching the Touch/Talk switch.
- 4. Touch/Talk Switch** Controls talk/listen communications. Operator touches switch to talk and cancel alert tone. Operator releases switch to listen.

- 5. Indicator Lights** Yellow light indicates presence detection. Red light indicates TALK mode. Green light indicates LISTEN mode. Yellow light above "standby" comes on and other lights are extinguished when Intracom is muted by placing it in the "standby" mode.

**Multiple Intracoms** When two or more D-15 (D) Intracoms are connected to the same speaker, using one Intracom locks out the other. The red *and* green lights on the "locked out" Intracom illuminate, showing another Intracom is in use. Pressing the talk switch on a "locked out" Intracom causes a busy tone.

*Note:* Optional music/message source cannot be used with multiple Intracoms.

## Operating Instructions

(Be sure transformer is plugged in.)

- Slide Power Switch to right. (The green "power-on" light activates.)
- Touch Talk Switch while speaking. (The red "talk" light activates.)
- Release Talk Switch to listen. (The green "listen" light activates.)
- Adjust the thumbwheel (listen) volume control.
- Touch the Standby Switch. (The yellow "standby" light activates.)
- The "talk" and "tone" volume are set by the installer. For details, refer to installation instructions.
